Rules and Regulations

- Each contestant will be given a whole pie. The first person to eat the entire pie, including the crust, will be declared the winner. If no one has eaten the entire pie within a 5 minute period, the person who has consumed the most pie will be declared the winner.
- In case of a “tie” the judges will be asked to determine the winner. The decision of the judges is final.
- Your hands must remain behind your back for the duration of the contest. You may NOT use your hands at any point in the contest.
- No beverages can be consumed during the contest.
- You will be disqualified should you be unable to keep the pie down.
- Signed registration forms are required.
- Contest will have three age divisions: 8-12, 13-18, 19 and over.
- **Contest is open to the first 10 people who sign up in each category.**
- Winner in each division will receive a ribbon, a \$25 Gift Card, and Bragging Rights.
